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3. This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to grant parole in case FIR No. 180/2010 under Sections 302/34 IPC registered at PS: Kanjhawala for a period of 03 months along with personal bond.
