1. While learned counsel for the applicant/appellant has drawn the attention of the Court to the MLC, learned APP for the State as well as learned Amicus Curiae have referred to the testimony of PW-6/Doctor, who has proved the MLC as well as the testimony of the child victim. Learned APP for the State further submits that the appellant has not even undergone half of the sentence imposed upon him.
2. After going through testimony this Court is not inclined to entertain the present application at this stage. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
