ORDER

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1. Pursuant to previous order dated 3rd April 2024, status report has been filed as per which, a single piece of ammunition was detected in registered baggage of petitioner who was travelling by Air India Flight no.AI 825, whereupon he was asked to produce valid license for the recovered cartridge but he could not produce the same.
2. The explanation given by the petitioner regarding the one live cartridge was that it was of his cousin Danish at Lajpat Nagar market, who had put it in his bag.
3. In the circumstances, considering explanation given by the petitioner and no other circumstance being found that petitioner was carrying any arms, in the interest of justice, present FIR NO: 138/2017 under Sections 25,54,59 Arms Act P.S.: IGI Airport stands quashed considering that there was no



conscious possession of the one cartridge, by the petitioner.

4. Petition stands disposed of along with pending application, if any.
