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1. The present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 482/483 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:

“a) Issue direction/ order to effect the Office of Special Commissioner of Police, Economic Offences Wing, P.S. Mandir Marg, New Delhi, to register the F.I.R. against the Respondent No. 2, 3 and 4 pursuant to the complaint dated 17.05.2022, bearing diary no. D-1539/DCP/EOW (C-1199/22 dated 17.05.2022); and/or

b) Direct the Ld. ACMM, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi District, Delhi, to dispose the Complaint Case No. 2505 of 2022, in a time-bound manner; and/or

c) Pass any such order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in light of the present facts and circumstances.”

2. It is pointed out that the Learned Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate has heard the arguments on the application under Section 156(3)



of the Cr.P.C. and kept the same for pronouncement on 05.06.2024.

3. In view of above, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition as the same has become infructuous.

4. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
