1. Exemptions allowed, subject to just exceptions.
2. The applications are disposed of accordingly.

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3. The present petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. seeks the following prayers:-

“a. Allow the present Writ Petition and issue writ, order or direction to Respondents Transfer the petitioner to some other jail from Tihar Jail No. 2; OR

b. Allow the present Writ Petition and issue writ, order or direction to Respondents Transfer the prisoner Naveen Bali to some other jail from Tihar Jail No. 2;



c. Pass such other Order(s)/direction(s) in the interest of justice and in favour of the Petitioners, as may be deemed fit and proper by the Hon'ble Court under the facts and circumstances of the case.”

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a representation with respect to prayers sought in the present petition before the competent authority at the first instance.
5. Leave and liberty granted.
6. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.
7. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
8. Needless to state that on such a representation being made, the competent authority shall dispose it of as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four weeks.
