1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“i. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Respondent No. 2 to forthwith issue the IPC license card to the Petitioner for 2024;

ii. Issue an appropriate writ, order, or direction in the nature of certiorari to call for and set aside the decision of the Respondents Nos. 1 to 3 denying the



Petitioner from participating in Hangzhou 2022 Asian Para Games held in October 2023 as being illegal and arbitrary;

iii. Pass any other order this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and necessary in the interest of justice."
