1. By way of present application, the applicant/petitioner seeks condonation of 4 days' delay in re-filing the petition.
2. For the reasons and grounds stated in the application, the application is allowed, the delay of 4 days in re-filing the petition is condoned.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. The present Petition under Section 29 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking extension of mandate of the Arbitrator till June, 2024 for passing the Award.
