1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

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3. By way of the present petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner seeks an extension of the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of six months for concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal has expired on 20.02.2024.
