4. This Court has been informed that nothing further remains to be decided. The provisional admission granted to the petitioner in this case is made regular. Needless to state that the petitioner herein would continue to be entitled to the facilities available to (Economically Weaker Section) EWS students, as has been provided by the School

5. Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
