19. As petitioners M/s Radox Tradex Pvt Ltd, M/s Rosemerta Infrastructure Pvt Ltd and M/s Star Care Real Estate have not been chargesheeted, hence their application for quashing of the FIR is infructuous and deserves to be dismissed in the interest of justice.

Keeping in view of above submissions, the present petition seeking quashing of the FIR, registered in this case is vehemently opposed and it is prayed that the same may be dismissed in the interest of justice.
