1. The present application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been filed on behalf of the applicant/petitioner seeking early hearing of the instant writ petition.
2. Having heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the applicant/petitioner and having perused the averments made in the application, the same is allowed. The writ petition is taken up for hearing, today itself.
3. The application is accordingly disposed of.
4. Date already fixed i.e. 31.07.2024 stands cancelled.
