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1. The present petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 17.04.2023 passed in W.P.(C) 10345/2020.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the respondent, this contempt petition is bereft of any merits. As per the order dated 17.04.2023, the grievance of the petitioner with regard to non-supplying of the bank statements for the relevant years including deduction of T.D.S. on supply of the relevant documents was addressed to his satisfaction.
