1. It appears that pursuant to the order dated 26.04.2024, the appellant has filed the affidavit with the concerned Family Court.
 - 1.1 A copy of the affidavit has also been placed on record.
2. We are told that the Family Court has listed the matter on 22.05.2024, for further proceedings.
3. We may note that the parties are physically present in Court.
