1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

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3. By way of the present petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, the petitioner seeks extension of mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal by a period of six months for concluding the Arbitral proceedings and passing the Award.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the mandate of the Arbitral Tribunal is expiring on 03.05.2024.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has invited the attention of the court to the order dated 12.04.2024 passed by the learned Arbitrator. The
