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1. The instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been filed on behalf of petitioner seeking issuance of appropriate writ/direction/order directing respondent nos. 2 to 4 to ensure the safety of the petitioner by providing police protection to the petitioner against respondent no. 5 and from her associates and further directing respondent nos. 2 to 4 to take cognizance of the complaint filed by the petitioner and direct respondent nos. 1 to 4 to conduct investigation in light of complaint and submit detailed investigation report.
2. Learned counsel for the complainant/respondent no. 5 who appears through Video Conferencing (VC) seeks time to file his *Vakalatnama*.
