CRL.M.A. 29831/2024 (exemption)

1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application is disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 29830/2024 (seeking extension of time for 4 months)

1. By way of the present application, the applicant is seeking extension of time for the conclusion of trial.
2. Notably, the petition was disposed of on 15.01.2024, whereby the trial court was requested to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within a period of six months from the next date of listing, which was statedly on 26.02.2024.
3. Learned APP for the State, on instructions, states that out of the 23 witnesses cited by the prosecution, 20 witnesses stand examined and on the



next date of hearing, i.e., on 08.10.2024, the Investigating Officer has been summoned.

4. Considering the request made, the Trial Court shall make an endeavour to conclude the trial within six months from the next date of hearing.

5. In view of the above, the application is disposed of.

6. Needless to state that as observed in the order dated 15.01.2024, the liberty earlier granted to the applicant would remain available to him, in case he so desires.
