1. Exemption is granted subject to all just exceptions.
2. The petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules before the next date of hearing.
3. The application is disposed of.

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4. This is a petition filed under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 seeking extension of mandate of the learned Sole Arbitrator for making and publishing the award.
5. It is stated that there was a bereavement in the family of the learned Sole Arbitrator and hence the petition for extension.
6. Issue notice. Ms. Dauk, learned counsel for the respondent appears on advance notice and has no objection to the petition being allowed.
