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1. The present petition has been filed, under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, seeking extension of the mandate of an Arbitral Tribunal, which is in *seisin* of disputes between the parties under two *Notification of Award of Contracts* dated 11.12.2008.
