4. The present petition has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner- M/s S.C. Agarwal under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The Petitioner seeks extension of the mandate of the Id. Sole Arbitrator by a period of 6 months.

5. It is stated that disputes between the parties herein arose, subsequent to which, the Petitioner invoked arbitration vide its letter dated 3rd February,



2021 in terms of Clause 64 of the General Conditions of Contract of Indian Railways. Vide order dated 29th January, 2021 the Court was pleased to appoint an arbitrator for adjudication of disputes between the parties herein. It is further stated in the petition that the matter is now at the stage of final arguments and the last hearing in the case was on 27th March, 2024, which was also the date on which mandate of the Id. Arbitral Tribunal had expired.

6. Ld. counsel for the Respondent has no objection. Accordingly, the mandate is extended till 31st December, 2024.
