CRL.M.A. 15092/2025 (Exemption)

1. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The Petitioner shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.A. 15091/2025

4. Through this application, the Petitioner seeks direction for release of the amount of INR 1,00,000/- deposited with the Registry as a part of the pursuant to the condition imposed by this Court by order dated 30th October, 2023 allowing him to travel abroad.
5. This aforementioned order was passed on account of the operation of an



LOC issued against the Petitioner, which prevented him from travelling abroad. Subsequently, by order dated 10th July, 2024, the LOC itself has been quashed. The said order was thereafter modified by order dated 29th July, 2024.

6. In light of the aforementioned developments, since the LOC itself stands quashed, the amount deposited by the Petitioner in terms of order dated 30th October, 2023 is directed to be released to the Petitioner along with accrued interest, if any.

7. With the above directions, the present application is allowed and disposed of.
