1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“a. Issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other writ(s) or direction(s) directing the respondents no.1 to expedite the matter titled as Ms. Usha Rani & Anr. Vs. Shri Raj Kumar Singh & ors. vide appeal No. 778/2023 pending in the Ld. Divisional Commissioner, Appellate Authority, 5, Shamnath Marg, Delhi;

b. direct the respondent no.4 to vacate the suit property



of the petitioner from the respondent no.2 and 3.

c. Any other further orders which this Hon'ble court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case be passed in favour of the Petitioner and against the Respondents."

2. The material on record indicates that the matter is under active consideration before the authority constituted under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007.
3. Since the matter is under consideration before the authority, this Court is not inclined to pass any directions to the authority to give a preferential treatment to the case of the Petitioner.
