The present petition has been filed to invoke the supervisory jurisdiction of this Court under Article 227 of the Constitution of India seeking time bound direction to learned National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi (“NCDRC”) to conclude the proceedings before it in time bound manner and for expeditious disposal of the first appeal no. 534 of 2017 titled as “Emaar MGF Land Ltd. & Anr. vs. R.
