1. Allowed, subject to just exceptions.

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2. After some arguments, counsel for the appellant says that he does not wish to press the appeal.

3. It is, however, the submission of the counsel for the appellant that there may still be a possibility of having the matter settled as the divorce action instituted by the appellant is pending adjudication before the Family Court.

4. The suggestion made by the learned counsel for the appellant is that parties could be referred to a Mediator attached to the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre [in short, "Centre"].

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5. Counsel for the respondent says that the respondent would not be averse to any such direction being issued by the Court.
6. Accordingly, the appeal is closed.
7. However, parties along with their counsel, are directed to present themselves before the Centre, on 22.05.2024, at 3:00 PM.
8. The Mediator will submit the report to the concerned Family Court.
9. The case papers shall stand consigned to the record.
