I.A. 3990/2024 (under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908) and CS(COMM) 489/2023.

1. At the outset, Mr Kunal Khanna, counsel for the Defendant, states that the cost imposed in terms of order dated 10th January, 2024 has been deposited. He states that he shall furnish proof of such payment to the Registry.
2. This is a joint application on behalf of the parties under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 whereby the parties jointly pray for a decree in terms of the settlement enumerated in paragraph no. 2 of the application.
3. Counsels mentioned in the appearance above, confirm the settlement and pray that the suit be decreed in terms thereof. The aforementioned application is duly supported by affidavits of the Authorized Representatives of the parties.
