1. The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 29A of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for extension of the mandate of the arbitral tribunal, which is in seisin of disputes between the parties in two arbitration proceedings, referred to in the petition as *Sarju-II* and *Sarju-III*.



2. I am informed that the learned Arbitrator is hearing both arbitrations simultaneously.
