1. The instant joint application under Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 has been filed on behalf of both the parties seeking disposal of the writ petition in terms of the settlement agreement entered between the parties.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties submitted that the dispute between the parties stands settled with the intervention of the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre vide settlement agreement dated 9th January, 2024 and the same is on record.
3. This Court has perused the Settlement Agreement dated 9th January,
