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1. This petition has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner seeking the following reliefs:-

“(a) issue a writ order or direction inter-Alia in the nature of a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to recall the lookout circular or in the alternative a writ of certiorari issuing directions to quash the lookout circular issued by the respondent against the petitioner;
