By way of the present application filed on the principles of section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908, the applicant/petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition in terms of Settlement Agreement dated 29.03.2024, a copy of which has been filed alongwith the application.

Mr. Chirag M. Shroff, learned counsel is present on behalf of the non-applicant/respondent on advance copy; accepts notice; and does not oppose the prayer made.

The Settlement Agreement, which is a culmination of negotiations under the “*Vivad se Vishwas-II*” (Contractual Disputes) Scheme, contemplates certain payments to be made by the petitioner/National



Highways Authority of India to the respondent/Gammon Atlanta-JV in accordance with Schedule-I appended to the Settlement Agreement.

The court is satisfied that the parties have resolved their disputes through lawful means by way of the Settlement Agreement.

The parties shall remain bound by the terms of Settlement Agreement dated 29.03.2024, in particular by the terms contained in Schedule-I thereto.

The application is allowed and disposed-of.
