ORDER

15.03.2024

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1. The Petitioner has approached this Court seeking compliance of the Order dated 10.02.2023 passed by the Ld. Central Information Commission (CIC).
2. Though Section 20 of the RTI Act provides for consequences of not supplying information or delay in supplying information without any reasonable cause, this Court on 04.12.2023 had issued notice in the writ petition in order to save the Petitioner who comes of lower strata of society from one more round of litigation.
3. Reply has been filed by the Respondents. It is stated that reply was sent to the Petitioner, however, it was sent back as the address was wrong and, therefore, the reply has been annexed with the counter affidavit. A perusal of the counter affidavit and reply shows that all the queries raised by the Petitioner barring query Nos.3 and 5 have been answered. It is stated that



query Nos.3 and 5 are vague.

4. Query No.3 reads as under:

3.	आपके कार्यालय के अंतर्गत रोजगार कार्यालय से जो डिमांड लेटर के माध्यम से वर्ष 2010 को आवेदक मांगे गए थे, चपड़ासी पदों पर मुझे उस डिमांड लेटर की तमाम रिकार्ड की सत्य छाया प्रति उपलब्ध कराई जाए।	मांगी गई जानकारी स्पष्ट एवं विशिष्ट नहीं है। इस कारण उपलब्ध नहीं कराई जा सकती है।
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5. This Court is also of the opinion that Query No.3 is vague.

6. Query No.5 reads as under:

5.	आपके कार्यालय के अंतर्गत वर्ष 2010 में जो चपड़ासी पदों पर आवेदक नियुक्ति किए गए हैं। उससे संबंधित नोट शीट बनाई गई होगी मुझे उन तमाम रिकार्ड की सत्य छाया प्रति उपलब्ध कराई जाए।	मांगी गई जानकारी स्पष्ट एवं विशिष्ट नहीं है। इस कारण उपलब्ध नहीं कराई जा सकती है।
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7. This Court is of the opinion that Query No.5 is also vague.

8. In view of the above, this Court is of the opinion that the Order dated 10.02.2023 has been complied with.

9. The writ petition is disposed of, along with pending application(s), if any.
