1. By way of present petition, the petitioner seeks the following relief(s):

“...a. Pass a writ, appropriate writ(s), order(s) or direction(s) in the nature of writ of Mandamus thereby, Issuing directions to the respondents to take appropriate legal action against the culprits, in the interest of justice.

b. Pass a writ, appropriate writ(s), order(s) or direction(s) in the nature of writ of Mandamus thereby, Issuing directions to the respondents to provide the protection of life, liberty & property of the petitioner, in the interest of justice...”

2. The petitioner who claims to be married to one Ms. *Shronika* has preferred a complaint against his wife as well as against her relatives.

3. Learned Standing Counsel while referring to the status report submits that on the basis of the complaint of the petitioner , an FIR has already been registered being FIR No.550/2024 under Sections 117 (2), 126 (2) and 3 (5)



of BNS. He further submits that the mobile numbers of the Beat Officer as well as the SHO have already been provided to the petitioner. The IO shall supply a copy of the status report to the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

4. Considering the aforesaid, no further orders are required to be passed. The petition is disposed of accordingly.
