1. This application has been filed seeking modification of order dated 28<sup>th</sup> August 2024. *Vide* order dated 28<sup>th</sup> August 2024, the previous order of 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024 was partially rectified. *Vide* order dated 25<sup>th</sup> July 2024, the settlement agreement dated 02<sup>nd</sup> June 2023, which was arrived at, between the parties, was accepted and the petition was disposed of, granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
2. There are certain timelines which were agreed upon between the parties, are extracted as under:
