By way of the present petition filed under section 29A(3) of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 ('A&C Act'), the petitioner seeks extension of the mandate of the learned Sole Arbitrator appointed *vide* order dated 30.05.2022 made in ARB. P.No. 504/2022, who is seized of the disputes between the parties.

2. Issue notice.
