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1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayer:-

“i) Through Appropriate Writ direct to the respondents/competent authority/respondent no. 3 F.R.R.O. Mumbai office, to return immediately Original Passport bearing No. FA0449921-(i/a 12.07.2019 TO v/t 11.07.2029) issued @ MIA) to the petitioner, which is in custody since 28.08.2023, in the interest of justice.”

2. Ms. Nidhi Raman, learned CGSC for the Union of India, states that exit permit has not been issued to the Petitioner for the reason that a Lookout Circular (LOC) has been issued against the Petitioner by FRRO, Kolkata.

3. As far as the prayer for returning of the passport which lies with the



FRRO, Mumbai, the jurisdictional High Court would be the High Court of Bombay. It is always open for the Petitioner to approach the jurisdictional High Court for release of the passport.

4. With these observations, the petition is disposed of along with pending application(s), if any.
