2. This application has been filed under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (in short, 'Cr.P.C.'), praying for the grant of transit anticipatory bail in FIR No. 11201018240003/2024 registered at Police Station: Cyber Crime, Gandhinagar, Gujarat under Sections 406/420/120B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short, 'IPC') read with Sections 66C and 66D of The Information Technology Act, 2000, and later Sections



465/467/468/471 of the IPC were also added.

3. The learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is a resident of Delhi and has no link with the bank accounts involved in the alleged money transaction. He submits that he was not named in the FIR, but was only later named by one of the co-accused. He further submits that the applicant shall duly appear before the concerned court/Investigating Officer (IO).

4. Keeping in view the submissions made hereinabove and also the peculiar facts and circumstances of the present case, the applicant is granted *interim* transit bail for a period of 10 days, subject to the conditions:

- (i) that the Applicant shall not leave the country;
- (ii) that the Applicant shall duly appear before the concerned court/ IO within the said period; and,
- (iii) that the Applicant shall not, in any manner, tamper with the evidence of the case.

5. The application is disposed of in the above terms.
