ORDER

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1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 of the CrPC seeks following prayers:-

“A) Pass an appropriate, writ, order or directions, thereby directing that the incident dated 13.3.2024 and dated 18.3.2024 on the basis of which FIR NO..0225 dated 3.4.2024 was registered in the Police Station New Ashok Nagar, Delhi, be Investigated by the Central Bureau of Investigation or any other independent investigating agency and the detailed report be submitted before the Hon’ble Court;
B) Pass any other appropriate orders or directions as this Hon 'ble court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”

2. Learned Standing Counsel for the State, on advance notice, submits that after registration of the FIR, Section 307 of the IPC has also been added. It is further submitted that investigation in the present FIR will be conducted under the supervision of the DCP East and the complainant will



be informed of the steps taken in the investigation.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks leave to withdraw the present petition.

4. Leave granted.

5. The present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of .
