1. The Petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

“a. issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus, and/or any other appropriate writ, order or for direction upon the Respondent No. 1 to provide security to the petitioner immediately from the Respondent No. 3 to 9 and/or

b. issue a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus, and/or any other appropriate writ, order or direction upon the Respondent No. 2 in the nature of declaratory relief in view of the settlement in favour of the petitioner towards the outstanding payment of his credit cards and loans; and/or

c. Pass such other and further reliefs as this Hon'ble



Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of this case.”
