(ii) Issue a writ of mandamus and direct Respondent



No. 2 to provide complete copy of the order dated 20.08.2022 passed in PAO No.18/2022 dated 20.08.2022 along with entire pleadings and supporting documents referred,

(iii) Pass any other order as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit."

2. On 06.05.2024, the learned CGSC appearing for the Respondents prayed for some time to obtain instructions.
3. Today, learned CGSC appearing for the Respondents states that in the special facts and circumstances of this case, the Department has agreed to supply all the documents as sought for by the Petitioner in the writ petition. The statement is taken on record.
4. As far as pleadings are concerned, it is always open for the Petitioner to approach the Adjudicating Authority and it is for the Adjudicating Authority to consider the request of the Petitioner and pass appropriate Orders.
5. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of, along with pending application(s), if any.
