ORDER

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1. The Petitioner has approached this Court challenging Order dated 01.06.2022 passed by the learned Trial Court directing the Petitioner herein to pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- per month to the son and wife as interim maintenance.
2. These proceedings emanate out of the proceedings initiated under Section 125 CrPC.

5. It is made clear that this Court is only disposing of the matter without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case as it is a challenge to the order of interim maintenance.

6. The petition is disposed of along with pending application(s), if any.
