1. It is not disputed that the application for interim maintenance is still pending adjudication. The impugned order dated 08.08.2023, passed by the learned Family Court, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi, in Mt No. 158/2023, is only an *ad interim* order directing the petitioner to pay a sum of ₹15,000/- per month to the respondents as *ad interim* maintenance.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the financial position of the petitioner is not such that he would be able to pay ₹15,000/- per month to the respondents.
3. The petitioner is at liberty to agitate the said ground before the learned Trial Court.
4. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to withdraw the present petition. He, however, requests that the learned Trial Court be directed to decide the application for interim maintenance expeditiously.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as



withdrawn.

6. The learned Trial Court is requested to decide the application for interim maintenance expeditiously.

7. The date already fixed in the present petition, that is, 02.04.2024, stands cancelled.
