3. The present petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution seeking direction to the respondent to restore the supply of electricity of 2<sup>nd</sup> floor and ground floor of property bearing no. G-64(105), Gali No. 20-22, Rajapuri Colony, Uttam Nagar-110059.

Mr. Rishab Raj Jain, Standing Counsel who is appearing on behalf of the respondent on advance notice stated that as per the instructions, electricity connection of ground floor only has been disconnected and there are dues amounting to Rs.2030/-. It is further stated that if the dues are paid then the



electricity connection will be restored.
