ORDER

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1. Through this writ petition, Petitioner seeks a direction to Respondents No. 1 and 2 to dispossess Respondent No. 3 from property bearing no. 132-E, Dilshad Gargen, Opposite LIC Colony, Delhi-110095.
2. In the opinion of the Court, no fundamental or legal right is said to be breached that needs to be addressed through the present petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950.
3. In light of the above, counsel for Petitioner, after making some arguments, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to apply to the Court through other legal remedies, as available under law.



4. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, along with pending application, with liberty as aforesaid. It is made clear that the Court has not commented on any other legal remedies that the Petitioner seeks to avail, and if any such action is taken, the concerned Court shall consider the same on its own merits, in accordance with law.
