By way of the present application filed under section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure 1908 ('CPC') the petitioner/applicant seeks disposal of the present petition as having been rendered infructuous in view of the settlement between the parties based on an Offer of Settlement, stated to have been made by the respondent under the "*Vivad se Vishwas-II (Contractual Dispute)*" Scheme on 17.05.2024 on the Government e-Marketplace (GeM) portal, which counsel states, was accepted by the petitioner on 21.05.2024.
