1. The petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution, seeking a direction upon the respondent – Municipal Corporation of Delhi [“MCD”] to de-seal his property being No. 26/33, *First Floor, East Patel Nagar, New Delhi – 110008*.
2. Learned counsel for MCD submits that MCD has received a No Objection Certificate from the Property Tax Department and has also received a demand draft of Rs.75,000/- from the petitioner. MCD, therefore, proposes to de-seal the property within a period of two weeks from today.
