4. The petitioner seeks initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of orders dated 19.10.2019 and



21.11.2022 passed by the learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Shahdara District.

5. Learned counsel for the respondent is present on advance notice.

6. Learned counsel for the respondent requests for time to seek instructions. It is pointed out that the present contempt petition has not been moved within a period of one year which is prescribed for initiation of such proceedings.

7. However, this Court finds that the impugned order operates in favour of the petitioner and that the learned Trial Court has ample powers to get its orders executed in accordance with law. There is no justification to file the present contempt petition.
