1. Exemption is granted, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The Applicant shall file legible and clearer copies of exempted documents, compliant with practice rules, before the next date of hearing.
3. Accordingly, the application stands disposed of.

4. After some submissions, Mr. Pritish Sabharwal, counsel for the Petitioner, states that he would like to withdraw the present petition with liberty to apply to the Court again, once a decision is taken on the issue of



cognizance by the Trial Court. Mr. Sabharwal argues that the Petitioner is not an accused. On this point, Ms. Mishika Pandita, counsel for CBI, states that stage for taking cognizance has not reached as yet.

5. Be that as it may, the present petition, along with pending applications, is dismissed as withdrawn and disposed of accordingly, with liberty as aforesaid.

6. It is further observed that in the event that the Petitioner applies to the Trial Court for seeking permission to travel abroad and the conditions imposed are onerous, the Petitioner shall be at liberty to assail the same in accordance with law.
