1. The Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the *ex parte* Judgment dated 06.12.2022 passed by the learned Judge, Family Court-02, Tis Hazari in MT No.356/2021.
2. It is stated by learned Counsel for the Petitioner that pursuant to the said judgment, a settlement has been entered into between the parties and out of an amount of Rs.5,50,000/- which was due and pending at some point of time, a sum of Rs.3,80,000/- has already been given and that despite payment of the money, certain more demands are being raised by the wife. He states that the *ex parte* order may be set aside.
