1. Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been preferred on behalf of the petitioner for quashing of FIR No. 346/2019 under Sections 356/379/34 IPC registered at P.S.: Jagat Puri and proceedings emanating therefrom. Chargesheet has been filed under Sections 356/379/411/34 IPC.

3. Learned APP points out that though two accused are involved in the FIR, but the present petition has been filed by only one of the accused.
