**ORDER**

**21.08.2024**

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1. By way of present application, the petitioner/applicant seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.0374/2023 registered under Sections 419/420/467/468/471/120B IPC at P.S. Ghazipur, Delhi.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the name of present applicant has figured only in the disclosure statement of the co-accused, namely *Sneha Prabha @ Chetna Arora* and that the applicant is not a beneficiary of any of the alleged transactions. It is further submitted that the applicant is suffering from paralysis and that he has joined investigation pursuant to the interim protection granted to him by this Court vide order dated 15.07.2024.
3. Learned APP for the State affirms that the applicant has joined investigation, however, states that he is also involved in three other cases. It is further submitted that the role assigned to the present applicant is of conniving with the co-accused, *Chetna Arora*, inasmuch as the applicant



herein had procured and provided the co-accused with the fake Aadhaar Card and Pan Card, on the basis of which she had impersonated herself as 'Sneha Prabha' and had also opened a bank account in Canara Bank. Furthermore, learned APP states that even proceedings under Section 82 Cr.P.C. had been initiated against the present applicant. He, however, on instructions from the I.O., states that there is no transfer of money in the present applicant's account and that the I.O. does not need custodial interrogation of the applicant.

4. At this stage, learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is on bail in the other cases.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the interim protection granted to the applicant is hereby made absolute and it is directed that in the event of arrest, the applicant be released on bail subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000/- with one surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer/SHO of the concerned Police Station and also subject to the following further conditions:-

- (i) At the time of furnishing bail bond, the applicant shall provide the mobile number, which he undertakes to keep operational at all times during the pendency of the trial.
- (ii) The applicant shall join the investigation as and when asked.
- (iii) The applicant shall inform the concerned Investigating Officer about his current residential address.
- (iv) In case of change of residential addresses/contact details, the applicant shall promptly inform the same to the concerned Investigating Officer/SHO.
- (v) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly try to get in touch with



the complainant or any other prosecution witnesses or tamper with the evidence.

(vi) The applicant shall regularly appear before the trial Court.

6. The application is disposed of in the above terms.

7. Needless to state that nothing observed hereinabove shall amount to an expression on the merits of the case and shall not have a bearing on the trial of the case as the same has been expressed only for the purpose of the disposal of the present bail application.
