1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the genesis of the present petition is the award dated 01.03.2018 whereby the petitioner was not granted pre-suit interest.
2. Learned counsel submits that aggrieved of this, the award was challenged before the District Court by OMP(T) (COMM) 35/2017. Learned counsel submits that OMP(T) (COMM) 35/2017 tilted as *PARAMJEET SINGH NARULA vs. DELHI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY* was dismissed by learned District Judge, Commercial Court vide order dated 03.05.2023. Learned counsel further submits that against this order, the petitioner has filed FAO 77/2024 titled as *PARAMJEET SINGH NARULA vs. DELHI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY*.



3. Learned counsel submits that the present petition was filed for the appointment of an arbitrator for adjudication of the claim of the petitioner regarding the pre-suit claim. Learned counsel submits that since the FAO 77/2024 titled as *PARAMJEET SINGH NARULA vs. DELHI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY* has already been filed and the same has also been transferred to this Court, the petitioner may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to agitate/press her claim in FAO 77/2024 titled as *PARAMJEET SINGH NARULA vs. DELHI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY*.
4. In view of the submissions made above, the present petition along with pending application stands dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
