6. The matter will be withdrawn from the Court of Ms. Ankita Lal, ASJ/(FTC) N.E. KKD, Delhi and listed before the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Shahdara, Karkardooma Courts on 21.03.2024 for further allocation and proceedings.
